General Comments
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, one Educator was on site waiting for the children to arrive. The other Educators had left the facility to meet the children at the school dismissal time. The facility was clean, bright and welcoming. Each child has a hook for their jacket and bookbags and a cubby in the main room for indoor shoes and personal belongings.  As the children arrived by bus, head counts were observed as the children entered into the facility. Outdoor gear was removed, indoor shoes were put on, and hands were washed before the children gathered for afternoon snack. Once the last bus of children arrived, the children broke into their groups for the afternoon. Group A went to the gym to play active games. Today they were playing "Ultimate Chicken" which is similar to Ultimate Frisbee. The Educators sat with the group going over the rules of the game and broke into 2 teams. Both Educators were actively engaged with the children and were observed playing the game.  Group B was observed playing in the warehouse. Several blow up obstacle courses were set up in the room. The Educator explained the rules and expectations before playing X-Tag. Both Educators played the game and were well spread out to ensure proper supervision was maintained.  Later in the afternoon the children in the Warehouse transitioned to the main front room to play Spider Pong, read and play card games. The children who were in the gym transitioned to the back classroom where they were observed playing hand ball, card games and building at the Lego table. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. All Educators were engaged with the children throughout the afternoon and showed a genuine interest in their activities.
