The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that both the annual inspection report and the monitoring inspection report must be posted in a visible prominent place in the facility. Comments: While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the art and craft materials were all piled up on a shelf. The Quality Assurance Monitor explained to the operator that all materials and equipment must be easily accessible to children. A picture of the art and craft materials organized and easily accessible can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor via email.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Jan 19, 2024	
Comments: While on site the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the art and craft materials were all piled up on a shelf. The Quality Assurance Monitor explained to the operator that all materials and equipment must be kept clean and in good repair. The Quality Assurance Monitor also explained that the pile of arts and craft materials is dangerous if ever a child were to pull on something, the pile could easily fall on the child. A picture of the arts and craft materials cleaned and organized can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor via email.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jan 15, 2024	Jan 15, 2024
Comments: When the Quality Assurance Monitor arrived on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed a bottle of disinfectant wipes on the half wall next to the door. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all toxic and cleaning products must be locked and inaccessible to children. The operator put the disinfectant wipes away where they were inaccessible to children. Deficiency is now compliant.
