Comments: 1 child's record is missing the full address of the emergency contacts. Operator must ensure that this information be indicated in the children's record.

Comments: Operator advised the Inspector that a child was sent home from the daycare yesterday due to vomiting. Inspector asked if a management of potential illness form was filled out, Operator indicates that this was not done and does not know which form the Inspector is referring to. Inspector showed Operator the form and Operator was able to locate the form. Deficiency is now compliant			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jun 25, 2024	
Comments: Inspector observed a hole in the wall of the entryway of the facility. The hole is covered with duct tape. Operator must ensure that this is repaired, in order to ensure that the indoor play area is maintained safe and clean.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jun 17, 2024	
Comments: A snowplow blade is located in the children's outdoor play area. Operator indicates that they are aware that this must be removed in order to ensure the safety of the children. Operator must ensure additional supervision around this area of the outdoor play area until the blade can be removed.

Comments: 1 child's water bottle is not labelled with their name. The Operator labelled the water bottle immediately. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector observed that the Operator washed their hands after changing a child's diaper. However, the child did not wash their hands. As indicated on the Diaper Changing Procedures, children must wash their hands after a diaper change. This was addressed with the Operator by the Inspector and the child washed their hands immediately. Deficiency is now compliant			
45(3) If a child has or may be affected by a disease that is required to be reported under the Public Health Act and the regulations under that Act by the operator of a licensed facility, the operator shall (a) complete the forms provided by the Minister.	45(3)(a)	Jun 18, 2024	
Comments: Operator advised the Inspector that a child was sent home from the daycare yesterday due to vomiting. Inspector asked if a management of potential illness form was filled out, Operator indicates that this was not done and does not know which form the Inspector is referring to. Inspector showed Operator the form and Operator was able to locate the form and filled it out during the inspection. Operator must obtain the parent's signature on the form.

Comments: 1 child's lunch box is not labelled with the child's name. The Operator labelled the lunch box immediately. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed indoor play, outdoor play, lunch time as well as the rest period. Inspector observed that the children had a large variety of outdoor play equipment and materials. The children were engaged in playing with the water tables that were at their disposal. The Operator ensured that the children were changed into dry clothes after they finished playing with the water.</p> <p>A child hurt themselves during the inspection. Inspector observed the Operator consoling the child, applying ice to the affected area and filling out the required incident log. A conversation was had with the Operator regarding the difference between an incident log and an incident report. Inspector recommends that Operator review Section 6.5 of the Operator Manual to obtain further information regarding this.</p> <p>Operator must follow up with the parents regarding a child's EpiPen. Should a label be required, Operator must ensure that this is added.</p> <p>A reminder to ensure that sunscreen is kept out of the children's reach when not in use.</p> <p>Ratio is respected during the time of the inspection.</p>
