During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed indoor play, outdoor play, lunch time as well as the rest period. Inspector observed that the children had a large variety of outdoor play equipment and materials. The children were engaged in playing with the water tables that were at their disposal. The Operator ensured that the children were changed into dry clothes after they finished playing with the water.

A child hurt themselves during the inspection. Inspector observed the Operator consoling the child, applying ice to the affected area and filling out the required incident log. A conversation was had with the Operator regarding the difference between and incident log and an incident report. Inspector recommends that Operator review Section 6.5 of the Operator Manual to obtain further information regarding this.

Operator must follow up with the parents regarding a child's EpiPen. Should a label be required, Operator must ensure that this is added.

A reminder to ensure that sunscreen is kept out of the children's reach when not in use.

Ratio is respected during the time of the inspection.
