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General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection. While verifying the amount of professional development hours completed for the current renewal year, the Quality Assurance Monitor only observed a certificate for 2h completed. The operator confirmed that she completed a total of 10h but did not receive all her certificate of completion. The operator informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that she reached out to her Early Learning Consultant to obtain all her certificate of completions. Once received they can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator regarding nap time. The operator informed the Quality Assurance monitor that the children don't sleep for more than 2 consecutive hours at a time. The children were observed playing in the indoor play area in reason of the rain outside. The operator confirmed that the children go play outside for at least one hour in the morning and in the afternoon if the weather permits outdoor play time. The children played with a sensory table with a Canaday Day theme. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children drawing on a drawing tablet, and pretending to sing with a microphone built with connecting blocks. The children were also engaged in showing their butterfly who was previously a chrysalis. The children were also engaged in a painting activity with bubble wrap. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children transitioning to eat their lunch (lunch boxes) and after nap and quiet time. Positive interactions were observed between the operator and the children.
