Comments: Deficiency is now compliant During the monitoring inspection the laundry room door was observed to be open in the afterschool area. Cleaning supplies were visible and within reach of children. The operator was able to lock the laundry room door before the monitoring inspection was completed.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Regular monitoring inspection was performed on this date. Children were observed both inside and outside of the facility.</p> <p>Within the facility was organized, clean and inviting for play. Each room had developmentally appropriate materials in sufficient quantities for the children in attendance. Children were having afternoon snack and were seated at the tables.</p> <p>School age classroom was observed, however all school age children were outside during the inspection and were engaged in several activities. The educators were in the process of refilling the sandbox area and the children were enjoying the fresh sand.</p> <p>Other children were in the wooded area and throwing footballs. Art activities were visible outside as children had been painting sticks, a handwashing station was available nearby and children could pump their own water to clean their hands.</p> <p>Educators were observed calling their classroom over by howling like a wolf, the children all joined in on this until all classmates were assembled together and then proceeded to walk back into the facility together.</p> <p>Positive behaviour guidance was observed at all times.</p>
