<p>Upon arrival of licensing staff, the infants were getting ready to go outside. The 4-5-year-old group was engaging in free play. The children were playing with magnets, and some were colouring. The group started cleaning up. The educators were heard praising the children for cleaning up. The children sat with an educator and were taking turns going to get their snowsuits. The children got dressed and the educators helped. The 2-3-year-old group also started getting ready to go outside. The school-age group was engaging in free play. The children were playing with Legos, colouring, and listening to music. One of the educators started preparing a process art activity. Water was added to a baking sheet, and the children were adding pastels to it. The children then put a piece of paper in the water and the pastels stuck to the paper.</p> <p>The infant groups returned inside. In one group, the educator was reading a book, and the children were seen exploring the materials in the play kitchen. The infants then washed their hands and sat at the table for lunch. The 2-3-year-old group returned inside, and the educators helped the children take their snowsuits off. The 4-5-year-old group was seen playing on the snow hill and sliding. The school-age group were colouring on shrink paper before cleaning up for lunch. The children washed their hands and the educators heated up their lunches. The 4-5-year-old group returned inside and took their snowsuits off. The children washed their hands and sat down for lunch. The educators were sitting with the children. After lunch, the children got cleaned up. The school-age group was playing with blocks and with melting beads. Some children were engaging in imaginary play, and some were on the climbing wall. The preschool group played with puzzles and magnets. One infant group was reading books, and the other was listening to "Hop Little Bunnies". The educator did diaper change before nap.</p> <p>The indoor environment was clean and well-organized. The walls are decorated with learning stories, pictures of</p>
