**General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the annual license renewal inspection. Staff arrived at the after-school program prior to the children's arrival for the afternoon. The Program Manager informed licensing staff that they were no longer permitted to access the gymnasium and begin program set-up until after the children had been dismissed from the school day, which differed from previous years. When licensing staff inquired about the reason for this change, the Program Manager explained that it was reportedly due to changes within the school curriculum schedule.

Despite this adjustment, the educators and administrator worked efficiently and collaboratively to prepare the program space in a timely manner before the children arrived. Upon arrival, children transitioned smoothly into the program by either sitting down for snack or engaging directly in play activities. Some children initiated a game of basketball in one half of the gymnasium, while another group participated in activities within the Lego and building centre.

Throughout the inspection, educators facilitated smooth transitions between planned activities. Children participated in a game of X-tag before moving into an organized craft and mark-making activity.

Educators were actively engaged with the children throughout the inspection and provided positive guidance and support when children experienced conflict with their peers.

All files reviewed were organized, complete, and contained the required documentation.

Licensing staff recommends the licensed facility for renewal of license.
