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General Comments Licensing staff arrived to conduct a monitoring visit just as the children were sitting down for snack. They provide the snacks and the menu was posted. Today's snack was trail mix and cranberries. There were some centers set up, but the educators arrive at the gym at the same time that the children do, so it takes them a few minutes to make this transition. They indicated that there were more toys and resources in storage, and I suggested that they needed to bring out more materials for the children's play such as furniture for the Barbie house and more building materials such as lego and different kinds of blocks etc. The time period between summer and winter needs a bit of a refresh and for materials and as they learn the children's interests they can add more specific things. There were 4 picnic tables set up in the middle of the room and some of the children were eating, and some were colouring and drawing with markers. There was a book corner with a mat and a few books and another group playing with magnetic connect shapes. The other side of the gym was being used for wall ball which was very popular. Everyone finished up, had a bathroom break, changed shoes and gathered their book bags for outside play. The educator brought a wagon with chalk, balls, skipping rope, 2 hula hoops, drawing materials, and small animals and toy cars. All the staff have walkie talkies, so they are always in communication. They divided the group up and some of the children went to the lower field to the gaga ball pit, and some chose to play in the upper playground on the climbers and swings. The educators keep each other up to date on the numbers of children in attendance and those that are being picked up etc. Final pick up was outside and staff took some children inside to get water or go to the bathroom as needed. Staff took their attendance and First aid kit outside with them and the parent board was at the gym entryway and complete and up to date. All the staff were attentive to the children's needs and practiced excellent supervision. It is a very large outdoor playground, and the educators knew where all the children were at all times. Child guidance was kind and pro-active and staff were genuinely interested in the children's wellbeing.
