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General Comments Upon licensing staff's arrival, the child was arriving at the home daycare. The child was able to engage in free play with the materials available in the space. The child played with playdough while the operator provided various accessories for the activity. The operator engaged the child in conversation about their daily routine, and the child responded promptly. The environment is set up with a variety of areas to support different types of play and learning, including crafts, science, literacy, dramatic play, games, blocks, puzzles, and other activities. The child then engaged in dramatic play while the operator participated in the play. They later played with building logs, and the operator engaged the child by asking which building blocks would fit together. The operator then asked the child if they were hungry and prepared their lunch box for snack. The child ate at the table before getting ready to go outside. The operator assisted the child with getting ready, and they headed out for a walk to the park. The operator brought a first aid kit, water bottles, and snacks. Upon arrival at the park, the child was able to play freely on the play structure. There is currently one child enrolled in the preschool program. The after-school group was not observed during the visit; however, the space is equipped with age-appropriate materials to support their play and activities. Child and staff files were reviewed and found to be in order. Only positive child guidance was observed. Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
