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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Children were engaged in a number of activities in the morning. Tables, floor mats, and trays had playdough with tools, a variety of wooden blocks, mark making materials with scissors, sensory bins and green water in containers with funnels for pouring. Educators sat with children and asked prompting questions while taking interest in their play. The routine allowed for large periods of uninterrupted time for play. The accessible materials and routine also allowed for the children to independently choose what they wanted to play with.</p> <p>Children had the autonomy to choose when they wanted snack and staff routinely wiped the tables in between children eating. A visual daily routine is posted in both the library and by the door and it was evident that children were familiar with the routine and expectations.</p> <p>Before lunch children had circle time and outdoor play. The transition to getting dressed for outdoors was smooth and staff were on hand to help children. Time was also provided for children to try dressing on their own.</p> <p>The outdoor play space had a clear path, and the operator is sanding the ice as required. A large bin had a wide variety of materials for the children to play with. Incident reports were promptly filled out when two children took a small fall on the ice. The fence is in good repair and the gate securely latches.</p> <p>The facility was clean with organized materials. Extra supplies and resources are tidy and placed in wooden bins.</p> <p>Staff and child files were organized and required all documentation.</p> <p>Recommendation for renewal pending a new fire inspection.</p> |
