<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, some children were observed having morning snack while others were engaged in a variety of activities. At one table children were seen playing with a bin of animals, trees, plants and wooden discs. One child was eager to tell Licensing Staff about the different animals and where they lived.</p> <p>Later in the morning an Educator softly rang a bell to get the attention of the children. The Educator stated it was time to tidy up the classroom and meet their Educator for gathering time. The transition to small group gathering time was smooth. Once the children were in their group, the Educators were observed welcoming each child and individually asking them how they were feeling today. All groups were observed reading a book and doing a painting activity. In one group, the class has been discussing Holi. The group read "Festival of Colors" followed by a colorful craft.</p> <p>As the groups finished gathering time, the children used the washroom and got ready to go outside. Outside the children were observed playing with the mud kitchen, using mixing bowls and scoops to make "stew". Other children played with trucks and a wooden teeter totter. One Educator stayed inside the facility tidying up and getting lunches prepared.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. It is evident the children are familiar with the daily routine and comfortable in the environment. The Educators were involved in the children's play and were heard offering praise, hugs and high fives and acknowledging their accomplishments "You did great!". Child profiles were reviewed and contained all required documents.</p>
