20 For the purposes of section 17 of the Act, the requirements with respect to the transportation of children are as follows: (c) the driver of a motor vehicle and the motor vehicle must be in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act and the regulations under that Act.	20(c)	Dec 08, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the motor vehicle registration sticker expired November 2023. The operator shall ensure that the bus is in compliance with the Motor Vehicle Act before transporting children.			
21 A licensee shall post the following documents in a clearly visible and prominent place in the facility associated with the licence: (a) the licence; (b) a report provided under section 23; (c) an order issued under section 28; and (d) a probationary license issued under section 29.	21(a) – (d)	Dec 08, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the latest renewal inspection is not posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. The operator must ensure that the renewal inspection report and monitoring inspection report are posted inside the facility.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (iv) the name, address and telephone number of at least two individuals authorized by the child's parent or guardian to pick up the child and to be contacted in case of an emergency if the parent or guardian cannot be reached,	24(1)(b)(iv)	Dec 11, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the 2 emergency contacts listed in 1 of the 4 child files audited have the same phone number. The operator must ensure that the name, address and telephone number of at least two people authorized by the child's parent to pick up the child and contact in case of emergency if the parents cannot be reached is noted in all children's files.			
28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act.	28(3)(a)	Dec 08, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that there is no hand soap available in one of the bathrooms. During the inspection, an educator placed a bottle of hand sanitizer in the washroom. The operator must ensure that hands are washed following proper hand washing procedures in the Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) Facilities, Appendix 39.

46(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall only administer medication to a child receiving services at the licensed facility in the following cases: (c) if the medication is not prescribed, the medication is (i) in the original container with the original label, (ii) in a container with child protective caps (iii) labelled with the child's name and the dosage.	46(1)(c)	Dec 08, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that part of the label on a bottle of non-prescribed medication is missing making the medication unidentifiable. The bottle is also not labelled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that all non-prescribed medications are in their original child safe container with the original label and labelled with the child's name and dosage.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Dec 11, 2023	
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observed that 2 out of 4 lunch boxes verified are not labeled with the name of the child. The operator must ensure that all food brought from home is labeled with the child's name.

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the children's arrival, snack time, indoor free play and outdoor free play.
