Comments: The inspector observed that the report is posted in a visible area inside the facility. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the name, address and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contacts are present in the 3 child files audited. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that soap is available in both washrooms. Deficiency is now compliant.			
46(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall only administer medication to a child receiving services at the licensed facility in the following cases: (c) if the medication is not prescribed, the medication is (i) in the original container with the original label, (ii) in a container with child protective caps (iii) labelled with the child's name and the dosage.	46(1)(c)	Dec 08, 2023	Jan 19, 2024
Comments: The inspector observed that non-prescribed medication is in the original child safe container with the original label. Deficiency is now compliant.
