General Comments

- -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -All staff records contain required checks and documentations
- -The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- -Major incident report was reviewed with the administrator on what incident is considered reportable and which one is not.
- -Minor incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- -Educators facilitate children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end questions.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- -Reminded one staff to date documentation and learning stories added to children's portfolios.
- -Through out the center, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitations, photos and learning stories were posted.
- -Diaper changing station is found in one of the washrooms. Individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- -The diaper changing procedure was reviewed and revised in collaboration with staff to ensure best practices and compliance with hygiene standards.
- -The designated napping spaces within the center is the classrooms for children between two and four-yearsold.
- -Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height and is in good repair
- -Operator/administrators confirm that all bedding material is washed weekly by herself....by the parents if it has been used
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
