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General Comments

- -Morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -The diaper changing station is found in the washroom, individual space is provided for diapers and changing necessities. The changing pad is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non-absorbent layer, it is separated from the food preparation and is located one meter or less from a sink and children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- -Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- -Within the home base setting a room next to the playroom is designated has a napping room. Each child has a designated cot and a play pen for infants (0-23 months) are also within the room. The operator confirms that the sheets and blankets are washed weekly by the parents
- -It was observed during the visit that children's guidance is done by listening to what the child has to say, open end questions are asked to have further details and emotions are reflected.
- -Fire drill practice was not documented for the past two months, operator was reminded to document the practice
- -Portfolio which highlight children's learning and development are not accessible, these needs to be available to children and families daily. To create the opportunities for children to revisit, explore their learning.
- -The daily information sheet for infants (0-24 months information about the child's mood, eating schedule, rest time, diaper changing) is completed every day and stored in a file
- -All children's files have been checked, profile and consent are all completed in due form

Observations: When arriving at the center kids were sitting at the kitchen table and getting ready for a snack. Once they were done eating, they all went to the playroom and got into a free play period, caring for their dolls, building pyramid out of cups, Legos and pizza making.
