<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Visit at the center for an unannounced monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -Administrator and educators are holding a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate -The administrator and more than 50% of educators are holding a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent -An inclusive environment is provided for all children -Daily activities include purposely planned and documented programming such as, time and space for and a free choice of play experiences. Indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity, individual and group experiences, opportunities for various forms of literacy. Opportunities to express creativity and interests, to explore the arts and sciences and to experience accomplishment and success. Opportunities to problem solving and to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships. -Easily accessible space is provided for personal belongings and is separated for each child. -Center has the proper number of functioning and available toilets and sinks -Cleaning supplies are locked and kept away from the children. -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are these required documents: The license, inspection report, daily routine, weekly menu, evacuation procedures, name of operator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector, life-threatening allergies, a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease (if applicable). Discussion with the educator suggesting that all documents be put on cardboard, so it would be easier to put away at the end of the week. - In the room, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning stories were posted. - Educators facilitate children's learning by engaging in play and asking open-end questions. <p>Observations: When getting at the center some kids were doing their homework and one child was playing on his own with blocs. Other kids arrived from school they got into free play, and they were eating their snack when I was leaving.</p>
