General Comments

- Mid day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- Posted in the front entrance are the following documents: The license, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies and when it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease while be posted on the front door.
- The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff also evacuation drills
- Monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records are completed
- In the room, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.
- Preschool children attending the center do not nap
- During the visit, it was observed that the educator is really engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked, and guidance is given in a respectful manner
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child.
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- New communicable disease posters were given at the operator

Observations: When arriving at the center children were playing a memory game and practicing their zoo phonics, they then played with play doh and made cookies, cinnamon rolls...etc and then switch their pretend play to the kitchen and started to pretend bake.
