| Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observed some Lysol wipes and a Febreze air freshener underneath the sink in a bathroom. The Administrator removed the toxic product and stored them in a lock storage.<br>Deficiency is now compliant.   |                           |                                      |                |

| Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the changing mat is ripped and is no longer washable and non-absorbent. The changing mat must be replaced.  |                           |                                      |                |
| 9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer. | 9(1)                      | Dec 20, 2022                         | Dec 20, 2022   |
| Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observes that the ratio was reduced during nap time in the under 15 month old classroom.<br>To ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, the child-to-staff ratio must be maintained at all times (even nap time) for children younger than 15 months of age. An educator came in the classroom and ratio was respected.<br>Deficiency is now compliant.                                      |                           |                                      |                |

In all the classroom, the inspector observed positive interaction between the children and the educators. For the snack in the afternoon, the children got to decorate each a Christmas cookie with frosting and sparkles.
