Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the changing mat is ripped and is no longer washable and non-absorbent. The changing mat must be replaced.

Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the inspector observes that the ratio was reduced during nap time in the under 15 month old classroom. To ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, the child-to-staff ratio must be maintained at all times (even nap time) for children younger than 15 months of age. An educator came in the classroom and ratio was respected. Deficiency is now compliant.
