Comments: Five staff do not hold first aid, only 2 educators onsite with first aid. Are advised to maintain 1 educator inside/outside with first aid.

Comments: Five staff do not hold first aid, only 2 educators onsite with first aid. Are advised to maintain 1 educator inside/outside with first aid.

Comments: Many missing times on the attendance sheets. A child was isolating and not marked out when sent home.			
28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act.	28(3)(a)	Jan 25, 2021	
Comments: Covid-19 guidelines for handwashing between groups not being met as educators and Administrator move between groups. Covid screening was conducted when Inspector arrived however there was no hand sanitizer available. Children arriving afterschool did not wash or sanitize their hands. *See comments below for additional non-compliances to the Public Health standards.

Comments: Entrance to playground has metal fence rolled up on the ground with sharp pieces protruding.			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Jan 25, 2021	
Comments: Play areas have cords hanging where 2 year olds could pull down old coffee maker down onto themselves. In Afterschool class there are exposed wires from old telephone lines. A heating register removed and stood up in a corner, posing a danger if it falls on a child.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jan 27, 2021	
Comments: Fencing is broken and rolled up so children step over it to access the playground.			
31(6) The outdoor play area of a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre at which services are provided to infants or preschool children shall be enclosed with a fence at least 1.22 m in height with a gate that is secured at all times when the children are present.	31(6)	Jan 29, 2021	
Comments: Both gates broken, fencing needs repair.

Comments: Center must have the proper number of toilets, there were only 2 functioning toilets. There must be 3 functioning toilets and sinks.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jan 25, 2021	
Comments: Toxic products are left out: Lysol spray, Lysol wipes, medication weight loss powder, cans of paint, Febreze spray. All cleaners in the storage cabinet; was left open. Must be locked and inaccessible to children.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Jan 25, 2021	
Comments: Medications are being stored in an unlocked cupboard over the fridge, must be locked. Weight loss medication was found on shelf in infant room. Was placed in the unlocked cupboard over the fridge.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jan 26, 2021	
Comments: Baby's beds and sippy cups are not labelled.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (c) stored separately for each child.	40(1)(c)	Jan 26, 2021	
Comments: Baby blankets were stored in a folder pile, all together.			
41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (b) covered with a non-absorbent layer.	41(1)(b)	Jan 25, 2021	
Comments: Babies being changed on a fabric cushion/mat in baby room. It is not water resistant and cannot be cleaned properly between use. Is not being sanitized.

Comments: Babies are being changed in nap room, must be one metre or less from a sink.			

General Comments

Washrooms are under construction. One bathroom door was off the hinges. Inspector requested it be removed as it posed a falling hazard. Staff re-attached the door. When Inspector tested it, it fell off into their hands. Was then again requested that the door be removed.

Children have access to toilet that is disconnected, as well as exposed hole and plumbing. A wire is visible under newly built wall. A broken hook on wall of functioning bathroom also visible and sharp.

Inspector noted that climbing wall mats moving frequently from proper area.

Playground structures must be off limits when surfacing is frozen.

Music in infant sleep room is too loud, must be turned down so that they can hear the infants if they cry.

* Public health standards not met due to the following:

Tables are not clean, were not cleaned before snack given to child. Some play areas, tv area in afterschool room, have dust, dirt. Toys need to be washed.

Change table has visible dirt in the table top, around the mat.

Garbage for diapers are uncovered.

No hand sanitizer available, all bottles were empty.

Cleaning lists are not being kept.

Child put down for nap with a dirty face after lunch .
