Staff members must: know the emergency plan and how to safely evacuate children in an emergency situation; understand their responsibilities; know how to physically remove children from the building, in particular, how to evacuate infants and children with additional support needs.

<p>Comments: Children were observed not washing hands upon arrival to the centre. Educator was observed not washing an infants hands after diaper changing. Staff and children must wash their hands as often as necessary but always in these situations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> upon arrival at the centre before handling food, eating or feeding after using the toilet after diaper changing after handling animals after outside play cleaning up after a sick child after handling items soiled with blood or bodily fluids before and after giving/taking medication <p>From the Diaper Changing Procedure Appendix 22: Wash the child's hands using proper hand washing procedures. Return the child to a supervised area.</p> <p>Entry way: Blue tile broken, to be repaired. Walls (all rooms): Some areas require crack-filling and painting (IE: Corners), Paint touch-ups required on all walls in all rooms: Infants, 2/3's, 4's and School-Age. 4's Room: Upper loft paint peeled from wall to be crack-filled and repainted. Ceiling above loft has marker/crayon marks, to be cleaned and repainted. White door trim between rooms dirty/grimy to be thoroughly cleaned. (Discussed the above with Administrator during inspection).</p>

<p>Comments: Infant Room: Materials lacking in room. Discussed with Administrator having toys on the floor in bins instead of up on shelves where the children cannot reach them. 2/3's Room: More blocks needed, Dramatic play area lacking in materials. Refer to NBCF-E Support documents as well as Operators Manual for ideas on how to enhance all areas in the learning environments.</p>

<p>Comments: 2/3's Room: Toy Piano keyboard dirty to be thoroughly cleaned. Bins where toys are stored to be thoroughly cleaned, accumulating dirt and debris.</p> <p>4's Room: Black mats under climbing wall ripped to be discarded and replaced with new mats.</p>

Discussed having materials accessible and available in all age groups, room arrangement and ensuring toys/materials are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.</p> <p>Educators were observed speaking respectfully and kindly to the children and comforting them when upset and redirecting behaviours appropriately.</p>
