Comments: Records must be completed each time a child arrives and leaves. Upon reviewing the records for this week, it was noted that a child was present in the 4/5 year old room but was not recorded on the attendance records, and the leave time was not recorded for two children in the School Age room on Feb 23rd.

Comments: Operator must create and post in the facility the written emergency plan for staff members, which outlines staff members responsibilities; lists items to be removed in an emergency (example, first aid kit, emergency contact information); shows the evacuation routes. Staff members must know the emergency plan and how to safely evacuate children in an emergency situation; understand their responsibilities; know how to physically remove children from the building, in particular, how to evacuate infants and children with additional support needs.

<p>Comments: Rugs must be vacuumed daily and cleaned as per Appendix D located in the Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Disease in Early Learning and Childcare Facilities. If there are areas of wear or lack of maintenance that interfere with good sanitation then Operator will need to replace the rugs. White door trim between rooms dirty. Administrator stated they cleaned them however they appear to need a fresh coat of paint to provide a surface that can be easily cleaned. Wall in School age room has a hole from sports-play, will need to be patched. Operator must provide staff with a written cleaning and sanitizing/disinfecting schedule that contains adequate detail with respect to area/item to be cleaned, cleaning frequency, materials used and who is responsible,</p>

31(6) The outdoor play area of a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre at which services are provided to infants or preschool children shall be enclosed with a fence at least 1.22 m in height with a gate that is secured at all times when the children are present.	31(6)	May 06, 2022	
<p>Comments: Administrator indicated that they must wait to repair fence and gate for the snow to melt and the ground has thawed. Operator will need to contact the QA Monitor once this work has been completed.</p>			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	32(1)(a)	Mar 04, 2022	
<p>Comments: Not enough books in infant room, 2/3 room. The 4/5 years room and school age room need more variety of puzzles and games. The 2/3 year old room would benefit from more variety of table top toys, for example things to stack, connect, weave, etc...</p>

<p>Comments: Books in infant and 2/3 rooms are torn and must be replaced.</p>

<p>Comments: Deficiency is now compliant</p>

<p>The back door in the school age room was difficult to open, Operator must check door frame and ensure any required maintenance is complete so that the exit will not be impeded.</p> <p>Educators were observed speaking kindly to the children, kneeling at their level and comforting them when needed.</p>
