General Comments

The QA Monitor met with the Administrators of the three facilities owned by the Operator, at the request of the Administrators, to discuss how they can support their staff to meet the requirements of Licensing Regulations: 24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall vii) be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (vii) documentary evidence of the child's learning; and

Licensing Regulation 21 The daily activities of a licensed facility shall be purposely planned in advance and documented and shall respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child and shall include

- (a) time and space for and a free choice of play experiences for exploration and discovery,
- (b) indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity, and
- (c) opportunities
- (i) for group and individual experiences,
- (ii) to explore various forms of literacy,
- (iii) to express creativity and interests,
- (iv) to explore the arts and sciences,
- (v) to experience accomplishment and success,
- (vi) to problem-solve, and
- (vii) to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships with educators and children.

Discussed the process of reflective practice using the resources in the Operator Manual and the Curriculum documents provided by the Province (the CAT, CAT-RG, NB Curriculum Framework & Professional Support Documents), provided examples of a variety of planning tools, and discussed the difference between documentation of children's learning and displaying children's work. Referred the Administrators to the early learning consultants in their region for further professional learning opportunities.
