Comments: Daily attendance records of children should be complete, showing all absences and detailing the reason.

Comments: In one of the classrooms, the cot didn't meet the requirements of 46cm between each of them.			
37 An operator of a licensed facility shall not permit a child receiving services at the licensed facility access to the kitchen unless the child is supervised.	37	Nov 25, 2022	
Comments: The door to the kitchen was unlocked. The kitchen door should always be locked unless staff is in the kitchen.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Nov 24, 2022	
Comments: In various classrooms, toxic products and cleaning supplies were found unlocked and accessible to children. Lysol wipes, Lysol spray and shaving cream were unlocked. The closet where toxic products are store was unlocked, the cabinet in the kitchen where toxic products are stored was also unlocked.			

General Comments

During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed snacks, indoor and outdoor play, meal and nap time. An educator was reading a story to the children while sitting on the floor with them. Children were sitting at a table in another class all coloring. In another class the educators were making snow with the children. Children received a Christmas Tree and are excited to decorate it.
