Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection and verifying new staff members file the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that one student did not hold a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate. While taking the child to staff ratio, the educator was alone in one classroom with the children. In reason of not having a valid first aid and CPR certificate, the educator can't be left alone with the children. Another educator with a valid first aid and CPR certificate went into the classroom. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: While verifying new staff members file, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed in 1 file that the copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate. The administrator could not confirm that the educator was not registered to complete her CPR certification. The Quality Assurance Monitor informs the administrator that the educator can never be left alone with the children. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards. Deficiency is now compliant			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Jul 29, 2024	Jul 29, 2025
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed some protective surface around the swings and the stationary equipment. However, the Quality Assurance Monitor ask that more wood chips are added. The administrator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that more wood chips will be bought and added to the necessary places in the outdoor play area as a protective surface. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site for a follow-up inspection. The children were observed sleeping, having circle time and playing in the indoor play area.

The deficiencies are now compliant.
