Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection. Inspector was able to observe the children play outdoors, one group having a picnic for lunch, lunch indoors and naptime. Children played freely in the afternoon while the center was getting ready for a bake sale that was about to begin. One group was doing sensory play with sand.							

Children were unable to go outside in the afternoon due to a weather heat advisory.
