Comments: The inspector was able to review documented evidence of the child's learning in 4 of the 5 classes covered by this license. One class had not documented the child's learning since January. The operator must ensure that evidence of each child's learning and development is consistently documented and maintained in the child's file.

Comments: Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection. The ratio was not respected in the infant classroom. The education returned to the room. Operator must ensure the ratio is respected at all times in a same age group. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection. Inspector was able to observe the children play outdoors, one group having a picnic for lunch, lunch indoors and naptime. Children played freely in the afternoon while the center was getting ready for a bake sale that was about to begin. One group was doing sensory play with sand. Children were unable to go outside in the afternoon due to a weather heat advisory.
