Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed one classroom with two educators accommodating three infants and four 2-year-old children. A discussion was held with the administrator confirming that the four 2-year-olds are currently registered as infants. When preschool children occupy infant spaces due to the preschool spaces being full and a transition not being possible, those children must be counted as infants in the child-to-staff ratio. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the administrator that the ratio is currently not respected, as all seven children must be counted as infants. The administrator immediately added a third educator to the classroom, the ratio is now respected. Deficiency is now compliant			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site to conduct a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is present throughout the morning, including during snack time, indoor play, outdoor play, lunch, and the transition to nap time. Children are observed engaging in a variety of activities such as reading books, playing with little cars, and building with Lego and magnetic shapes.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ratio and maximum number of children - Checks - Staff members records - Qualifications and training - Daily routine - Child guidance - Premises
