Comments: In one of the classrooms, one child was not signed in. Attendance sheets must be completed each time a child arrives and leaves and must reflect all children present at any given time. The educator immediately signed in the child. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(4) An operator shall ensure that the outdoor play area of a licensed facility (b) consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play.	31(4)(b)	Aug 10, 2023	
Comments: In the infant play area, Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that there was only one surface for children to play on. All outdoor play area must consist of more than one surface to permit different types of play. There was a little sand box, but the educator confirms that it is not being used and will be replaced with another one soon. A picture can be sent to QA monitor when the sand box is installed.
