Comments: The changing area is located in the hallway which is more than 1 metre away from the sink. Operator is waiting for a change table that attaches to the wall however is going to move her current change area into the actual bathroom.

Comments: Please insure that any time a child is picked up due to illness or illness related symptoms that potential illness forms are filled out.			

General Comments
<p>Children were going outside at time of arrival. Upon re-entry into the home they washed their hands and were offered water to drink. Water bottles are accessible to children and are labelled with their names on them.</p> <p>Operator is using "Owie reports" to document non reportable incidents. However, the incidents are being documented on the same page for different children. Advised Operator to keep information on different children confidential. Operator stated that they have not had any reportable incidents.</p> <p>Operator engages with children in a positive manner. They respond to the children's needs and gives gentle reminders.</p> <p>There was no evidence of a pre-planned program. However, operator is using pictures and picture blocks to</p>

document the children's experiences. Operator stated that she could benefit from curriculum support. A documented program needs to be apparent for licensing purposes.

All toxic products and medications are under lock and key in a closet. Advised operator that if they ever have medications that need to be put into the fridge that they would have to be locked too. Licensing staff recommended a lock box or bag to put it in.
