<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a follow-up license renewal inspection on February 2nd, 2023.</p> <p>When licensing staff walked into the 3-year-old preschool classroom, the children were lined up to go into the gym to play. While in the gym, the 4 year-year-old class, from the other license joined the 3 year-old class in the gym. Please ensure that when two groups, from two different licenses, remain separated while playing in the gym.</p> <p>While inspecting the preschool classroom, licensing staff observed a Valentine's Day craft the children painted using red paint. The hearts on the white paper were pre-drawn (similar to a colouring sheet) and the children painted the hearts using red paint. Licensing also observed a large piece of white paper with hearts pre-drawn</p>

on it; however, it was evident the children were able to have more choice while using bingo dabbers and markers to decorate the paper. Moving forward please provide the children with ample choice of paint colour and mark making materials in order for them to create their masterpieces.

Licensing staff has reached out to the curriculum team to visit the preschool classroom to give educators guidance on implementing curriculum based on the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework for Early Learning and Child Care.

The educators in the classroom were observed interacting with the children at their level and using positive guidance techniques with the children receiving services at the licensed facility. It was very evident the educators have built relationships with the children. During snack the educators asked the children what their favorite part of the day was. A majority of the children replied, "playing in the gym."
