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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning.</p> <p>Two- to Three-Year-Old Room and Preschool Room: The children were observed outdoors engaging in a variety of activities, including bubble blowing, water play, drawing, riding play cars, using spinning chairs, and playing on teeter-totters.</p> <p>The educators indicated that the two- to three-year-old children are currently interested in rainbows, sensory activities, and art. While preschool children are currently interested in animals, rice-based sensory activities, and water play.</p> <p>School-Age Room: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities that included playing baseball, soccer, and basketball, taking photos with a classroom camera, sitting in scoop rocker chairs, drawing, and exploring the wooded area using pots and shovels. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in sports, outdoor play, and art.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout all rooms, including photographs, learning stories, learning story books and children's artwork. The rooms were well organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, one educator file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.</p>
