General Comments
<p>Monitoring inspection performed. 1 deficiency to address going forward as stated above.</p> <p>Covid guidelines are followed and screening completed upon my entry. Please ensure educators are completing class daily logs (refer to November 13 Covid guidelines appendix D to enter children and class education names.</p> <p>Child guidance practices were observed during my visit. Educators were warm and spoke gently to the children when trying to settle them down for a nap.</p> <p>After lunch all children went down for a nap. The 4 year group only nap for a short time then participate in quiet play. The toddlers were being napped on cots/mats. One baby who turns 15 months next week was also being transitioned to the cot for napping. I observed the child settling down very quickly. Some children were taking much longer to drift off to sleep and the educators were observed comforting and rubbing the children's backs. The operator advised me she has ordered 2 cribs for the new year.</p> <p>Today's lunch served was sloppy joes, cut up cuc and and carrots. Parents provide the milk.</p> <p>A checked a few new educator's file and all in order.</p> <p>Lots of current programming observed. School age children were observed wearing masks after eating their lunch. I also observed children returning from outdoor play.</p> <p>Just want to emphasize the importance of handwashing at all prescribed times. Not all children know how to wash their hands using the 20 second rule. Refer to PH standards appendix 38 and Management of illness guide appendix 39 in the operator manual. I would recommend that babies have their hands and faces washed before going down for a nap after eating lunch.</p>
