Comments: A few things need to be addressed regarding general health standards - The handsink in the kitchen is not working and must be fixed. The Operator is aware. No staff should be washing hands in the double sink. The paper towel needs to be placed in the dispenser for sanitary reasons in the upstairs bathroom. Some nap mats need replaced or recovered as they are torn on the edges. The couch arms in the 2/3 room need re upholstered as they are getting worn and difficult to clean also.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	May 05, 2021	
Comments: The rock wall in the school age outdoor play area must be surrounded by protective surfacing as per manufacturers instructions. The operator plans to remove the climbers and use in the preschool play space as a play house. The balance beam in the preschool play space will be cut down to an appropriate height for safety reasons for this age group. I would recommend one child at a time. In the mean time please do not allow the children to use. thank you.			

General Comments
Monitoring visit performed. A few compliances to address as stated above. Covid guidelines are being followed and screening is taking place based on my visit today with exception of children's daily log sheets for contact tracing purposes. Some Educators were doing this today. All children were observed in outdoor play this AM. It is difficult for younger children to understand the concept of boundaries and their bubble group. The babies and 2's were in the same play area with tires being used as a

boundary to separate the groups. The facility thought it was going to rain today, so they wanted all children to experience outdoor play. I would recommend that children use the space at different times. It looks like the rain may hold off so children can go outside again after nap at different times if this can be arranged..

Lots of wonderful current learning stories posted throughout the centre and some staff are applying it to the curriculum framework. This is great! The educator is also sharing with the parents. Awesome! Some groups are into planting and growing vegetables and flowers.

I observed educators engaged and lots of interaction. Remember you can take your indoor programming outside too

Administrative forms were reviewed and attendance is being tracked for both children and staff (remind staff to add their last name on the form), last fire drill recorded on Mar 19th and outdoor checklist is being documented monthly. Incident reports are being tracked and signed by parents. Please make sure before they are misplaced they go to the incident report binder for non reportable events.

Most staff have completed or will be completing their ECE and one staff is on the waitlist for the 90 hours. This facility will be meeting the ECE training requirement by June 2022.
