This was brought to the educators attention during my visit and the educator updated the napping checklist form. Thank you.

<p>Follow up monitoring visit performed. This facility PH and Fire inspection reports are still outstanding. I am recommending to the Operator to follow up with these departments and request an inspection.</p> <p>Visitor logs are in place. As per the new guidelines dated June 28th, please keep a weekly log of staff and children for each classroom so this is accessible and available to PH for contact tracing.</p> <p>Administrative records reviewed - attendance documented daily for both staff and children, fire drills performed monthly, outdoor check list is maintained.</p> <p>Previous non compliances were verified during this visit. Balance beam lowered to an appropriate height and the hand sink is now in working order. Please remind educators to not identify both children on an incident report. They need to complete a non reportable incident for each child on separate forms.</p> <p>Staff were observed engaged with children, preparing for naps and comforting children at naptime, assisting with lunches, diaper changing, washing hands, speaking to children in a kind voice etc.</p> <p>3,4 , 5's and school age observed playing outdoors in the AM. Tomatoes, cucs and other flowers are being grown in the outdoor play area. Children observed involved in a variety of play opportunities. Children observed</p>

eating lunch before going down for nap. All children with exception of school age nap, though older preschool children are permitted to play quietly after having a rest.
