General Comments
<p>monitoring visit performed.</p> <p>Upon arrival, all children were observed in outdoor play - 2, 3, 4's. The babies were coming in from outside and educators proceeded to change diapers before getting children's lunch ready.</p> <p>When going down for nap always remember it's important to listen to children's cues and follow the child's lead and respond accordingly. One child was not ready to nap, but after taking a bottle and some soothing back rubs, the child fell off to sleep. It is important to allow a child time to settle down no matter how long it takes, especially when children are new to the surroundings. This is normal behavior. Please label cribs with the child's name in the nap room. All children were observed going down for nap. The school age children arrived for 1/2 day Wednesdays. Some children were taking lots of time to eat lunch,. After lunch some children watched a Christmas movie, the educator was observed playing cards with another group and a couple of children were enjoying some quiet time playing lego, k-necks and working on a puzzle.</p> <p>Administrative records were reviewed - fire drills are performed monthly and recorded, the outdoor checklist is maintained, incident reports are documented, and potential illness records are being completed and parents are signing off. Infant daily records are being completed however I did observe when babies came in from outdoor play, that the diaper change wasnot recorded on the daily info sheet. Please ensure all diaper changes are recorded. There have been a few children out with illness symptoms. It is important for educators to document the reason for absence on the attendance record. Parents must be providing the reason for absence when a child is not in attendance. It is important to help parents and staff understand that proper exclusion is one of the most effective measures in controlling disease. The centre is doing a good job and educators are following appropriate managing illness guidelines and completing potential illness forms when required when children must leave due to illness. Please remind staff to increase hand washing practices now that we are moving into the fall and cold season with the increase in illness symptoms.</p>
