General Comments

Follow up monitoring report. Daily info sheets were documented and had been completed for the past week. Upon entry, all staff attending to children's needs in all rooms. Appropriate child guidance was observed in all classes. Children seem happy and content (lots of smiles) though one little one was having a difficult day and while settling down for nap. The educators were observed sitting with the children and rubbing their backs. One group was playing and engaged with the educators. Another group the educator was trying to read a story to her group. It is important that all staff sit with the children and listen to the other educator reading the story rather than cleaning up from the other activity. Though ratio is maintained in the room, all educator's should be engaged and providing assistance to each other. The educator did go and sit with the children at my request. The educator followed the children's lead and after attempting to read a story moved the children into another activity and proceeded with bathroom breaks, washing hands for lunch. On the lower level, it is time to change up programming posted as some of it is dated back to February and March. The other groups were observed getting ready to eat lunch after bathroom breaks and washing hands. All children were observed eating lunch together. One group showed me the beaded bracelets they had made. Lots of current programming posted. All children nap or have a quiet time. It is expected that children will have an opportunity for outdoor play this afternoon. The rain appears to be tapering off. If children are dressed appropriately there is no reason for them not to go outdoors. Lots of places to play under the covered deck too, if it happens to shower. Administrator records were reviewed and outdoor checklist, Fire Drills, incident reports and potential illness reports are being documented and signed off by the parent.
