last visit, infants cannot be mix with other age groups, this means, the children arriving early morning cannot all amalgamate in one room when infants are present. Two staff members must commence at 7 am to ensure proper child-staff ratio is respected and so the groups can be separated. Another monitoring visit will be conducted to ensure compliance.
