### General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the Educators were in the process of meeting the children as schools were dismissed for end of day. Two groups were observed walking to the facility while the rest of the children arrived by bus. Personal belongings were hung up as they entered the facility.

Some children went straight to the gym while others were observed washing hands and starting afternoon snack as they waited for all groups to arrive. Once all the children were on site, they gathered in their groups and began their afternoon routine. The Educators were heard communicating how many children were in their group and what their plan was, ensuring all children had a chance to play in the gym area and classroom. Multiple headcounts were observed as the groups transitioned to their activities. Throughout the afternoon children were seen playing with Lego, building with magnetic tiles, playing Tetris Tumble and making paper airplanes.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children, asking how their day was and what they did over the weekend. The Educators were heard communicating throughout the afternoon which allowed for smooth transitions from one activity to the next. Attendance records were up to date and Fire Drills are being recorded.
