Comments: Inspector observed that the cleaning of the facility was not recorded as per the Covid-19 recovery phase recommendations. The form was created but no cleaning records were noted. The educator indicated that the toys and the centre are cleaned twice daily and that it will be added to the cleaning records. The inspector was not screened before entering the facility as per the Covid-19 recovery phase recommendations. The inspector directed the operator to ask the Covid-19 screening questions and to take his temperature. The screener is required to take records the following when an individual enters the facility: name, phone number, date/time of arrival and departure.

Comments: The inspector observed that the cleaning supplies containing toxic products were stored under the kitchen sink which is accessible to the children. The kitchen cupboards doors under the sink had an interior plastic child locks but was not locked by key. The operator stated that she will relocate the products in an inaccessible area and will lock the cleaning products by key.			

General Comments Inspector observed positive interaction between the operator and the children. The operator was engaged with the children throughout the inspection.
