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<p>General Comments</p> <p>The following elements were verified at the time of the monitoring inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The child–educator ratio. -The circulation areas and the outdoor pedestrian pathways are free of obstacles and hazards. -Time and space dedicated to play experiences, which are chosen by the children. The educator asked the children what they wanted to do. One child replied that he would like to go for a walk to see the kittens. -Opportunities to explore different forms of literacy. The educator helps the children write their names on the asphalt with chalk. -Opportunities to express their creativity and interests. The children also make drawings with the chalk. The educator encourages them to draw whatever they want. -Opportunities to experience accomplishments and successes. A child observes a yellow wildflower on the side of the road. The child said the name of the flower, "Marsh Marigold." Another child mentioned that he saw a daisy. Other flower names were mentioned. Another child observed a new type of purple flower. The educator took a photo and told the children that research on this flower would be done once back at the daycare. -Positive guidance of the children. The educator asked a child to walk more slowly, explaining that it is safer to stay close to the group. When the children stopped at the intersection, the educator asked them to explain the safety rules. The children explained and followed the safety rules well. The educator praised all the children. <p>At the time of the monitoring inspection, the quality assurance mentor observed the preparation for going outside (applying sunscreen), free outdoor play, a guided activity (flower picking and discussion about house numbers and street names), followed by writing their names and drawing on the asphalt.</p> <p>All questions were answered on site.</p>
