Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that children's Medicare number is present in the 5 child files verified. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that all staff member records include a copy of a criminal record check/vulnerable sector check. Deficiency is now compliant.			
24(3) Despite subsection (2), the records and documents referred to in paragraph (1)(b) shall be maintained for at least three years after a child is no longer receiving services at the licensed facility.	24(3)	May 22, 2023	Jun 12, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the administrator informed the inspector that separate folders have been created and that daily information sheets of children under 24 months will now be maintained for at least three years after the child is no longer receiving services at the licensed facility. Deficiency is now compliant.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	May 26, 2023	Jun 12, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that mulch had been added to the outdoor play area. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that plastic dividers are used to prevent mats from touching. The educators informed the inspector that the mats and plastics dividers are disinfected after each use. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that wipes are used for the intended children. Deficiency is now compliant.			
41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (d) no more than one metre from a sink.	41(1)(d)	May 15, 2023	Jun 12, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection the inspector observed that diaper changes are conducted on the change table in the bathroom which is located at less on metre from a sink. Deficiency is now compliant.			
41(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall (a) post diaper-changing procedures in diaper-changing areas.	41(3)(a)	May 15, 2023	Jun 12, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that proper diaper changing procedures are followed. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(4) If an infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall (d) ensure that each bottle is stored with a cover in the refrigerator.	48(4)(d)	May 16, 2023	Jun 12, 2023
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector was informed that infant bottles are now stored with a cover in the refrigerator. Deficiency is now compliant.
