Comments: In one preschool class, the paper & mark making materials were on a high shelf, out of the reach of the children. The educator stated it was moved up high because the children kept tearing the paper. Paper, along with all other play materials, must be accessible to children to allow for independent selection and must be placed on a low, open shelf.								

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The Administrator must confirm with the QA Monitor when all of the above listed orders for compliance have been corrected.

Recommendation:

In the infant room the children would benefit from the addition of soft toys & other soft items. These are permitted if they can be laundered. See Covid-19 Guidelines Document dated Dec 16, 2020 Appendix C - Cleaning and Disinfection.
