Comments: An infant was present in the 2 year old room. Infants cannot be mixed in a preschool room. The infant was moved to an infant room during the monitoring inspection. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: A staff member does not have the vulnerable sector check, which is required prior to employment. Staff was sent to obtain check immediately, and cannot return until the VSC has been obtained and is placed in their file.

Comments: This order for compliance from Jan 29 monitoring inspection has not yet been corrected: there are several staff (bus drivers and cook) whose files contain a job description that does not fit their assigned responsibilities. Staff members must have a job description that outlines their duties and responsibilities, they must read it and a copy be placed in their file.

Comments: A staff member does not have a vulnerable sector check in their staff file. Check must be obtained and a copy placed in the file.

<p>Comments: This order for compliance from Jan 29 monitoring inspection has not yet been corrected: in some rooms, there were no art materials available on low, open shelves. All indoor play areas must be provisioned so that all materials are accessible to children to allow for independent selection.</p>			
<p>36(7) A nap mat shall be at least 5 cm in thickness and stored in a way that avoids contact with the surface of another nap mat or disinfected on both sides after each use.</p>	<p>36(7)</p>	<p>Mar 02, 2021</p>	
<p>Comments: In one room, the bedding was placed on the stacked cots. This is not appropriate because the bedding is touching other bedding - risk of spreading communicable diseases. Bedding must only be placed on cots when the cots are set out and not touching other cots.</p>

<p>The Operator must send proof of the Vulnerable Sector Check to the Quality Assurance Monitor immediately upon receipt of the check.</p> <p>In follow up to the educator's purposely planned and documented programs, as noted on January 29th: Goal is that all educators are able to demonstrate that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on the children's interests, passions, strengths and abilities. All staff have begun using webbing and notebooks to purposefully plan and document their programs. This is a work in progress, and will continue to be monitored.</p>
