Comments: In one room, the bedding was placed on the stacked cots. This is not appropriate because the bedding is							
touching other bedding - risk of spreading communicable diseases. Bedding must only be placed on cots							
when the cots are set out and not touching other cots.							

## **General Comments**

The Operator must send proof of the Vulnerable Sector Check to the Quality Assurance Monitor immediately upon receipt of the check.
