| Comments: Outdoor play modules have been added to the outdoor play area without prior approval from licensing staff. Changes made to approved allocated spaces must be approved by licensing staff. Administrator will send their QAM a Change in Service application. No further changes will be made until the Change in Service is approved by licensing staff. | <p>Comments: During the inspection, inspector observed new modules that have been added to the outdoor play area as well as a large dirt pile. A discussion was had with the Administrator and the Corporation Director, who indicate that the outdoor play area is not currently being used by children due to current renovations. Before the children begin using the outdoor play area, Administrator must ensure that the correct protective surfacing has been placed around new play modules by verifying the manufacturing manuals and ensure that the space is maintained safe and free of hazards.</p> |                 |                      |                |
| <p>31(4) An operator shall ensure that the outdoor play area of a licensed facility (a) includes a shaded area that is at least 10% of the outdoor play area.</p>  | <p>31(4)(a)</p> | <p>Jun 23, 2022</p>  |                |
| <p>Comments: During the inspection, Inspector observed that shades have not been placed in order to ensure that 10% of the outdoor play area is shaded throughout the day. A discussion was had with the Administrator and the Corporation Director, who indicate that the outdoor play area is not currently being used by children due to current renovations. Before the children begin using the outdoor play area, Administrator must ensure that the proper amount of shade is added.</p>  |                 |                      |                |
| <p>48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.</p>  | <p>48(2)</p>    | <p>Jun 29, 2022</p>  |                |
| <p>Comments: Many lunch boxes and water bottles were not labelled with the child's name. Food brought from home must be labelled with the child's name. Inspector recommends that Administrator verify all children's lunch boxes and water bottles to ensure that they are labelled.</p>  |                 |                      |                |
