Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed tree fire extinguisher tags have been expired since November 2025. The administrator stated that they contacted the fire department to schedule verification but were advised that the department is currently experiencing delays. The administrator must ensure that all fire extinguishers are inspected annually and receive the new label every year by Fire Safety.			
28(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.	28(2)	Mar 02, 2026	
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observed that the fire drill for the month of January had not been completed. Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills must be conducted every month without exception.			
33(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment that includes the following information: (a) the review and repair dates; (b) the action required and the action taken; and (c) the name of the staff member who conducted the review.	33(3)	Mar 02, 2026	
Comments: The inspector observes that the review and maintenance plan have not been completed for the previous month of January. A monthly review and maintenance plan must be completed on all stationary equipment showing, the review and repair dates, the action required and taken and the name of the staff completing the review.			

<b>General Comments</b>
<p>The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection.</p> <p>During the visit, the inspector observed morning outdoor free play, one class creating art using snow and colored water, and three classrooms taking the children for a morning walk.</p> <p>The inspector observed free play, lunch period, rest period, afternoon snacks and in one classroom, children engaged in singing songs and reading a book.</p> <p>The inspector is unable to observe the protective surface surrounding the fixed structure due to frozen ground.</p>

General Comments

In addition, the inspector could not determine the types of materials because of the presence of snow. These elements will be reviewed at a later date.

A discussion is held with the administrator to clarify that eligible educators must complete the required 10 hours of professional development before the permit expiration date of March 31, 2026.
