Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The administrator locked the Lysol wipes in the designated area. Deficiency is now compliant.

The child-to-staff ratio was respected during the inspection.</p> <p>The following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The daily activities - Daily routine - Indoor play area and material - Rest area - Washroom - Storage space - Personal belongings - Diaper changing <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed one group of children going for a walk to explore in the rain. The children were also observed playing in the indoor play area, creating doll houses with playdough and pretending to have mustache with green painter's tape. The school aged children went to play in the baseball field, the were present for the full day in reason of a professional development day at school. The children were also observed transitioning to lunch time (lunch boxes). Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.</p>
