<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon entering the facility, it was noticed that the areas were set up with defined learning centres with many materials available to the children. Educators were engaged with the children at their level, having conversations and playing with them. Gentle reminders were given when children needed to be redirected. The calm environment was complemented with soft music playing in the background.</p> <p>A fire drill was completed at the time of visit. Educators in an organized manner left the classroom with the children. Attendance records followed the group, and the educators were able to disclose how many children they had with them to the administrator.</p> <p>As discussed, monitoring visit reports are posted and interchanged as the quality assurance monitor conducts visits. Renewal inspections and any follow ups to the renewal are posted for the 1-year duration.</p> <p>Please change my role to Inspector on the bulletin board. I am the inspector and Troy Williams in your Quality Assurance Monitor.</p> <p>As discussed, all consistent staff in the casual care license must complete 10 PD hours per year. I understand that there may have been some confusion as many of these staff work in the school age area as well. As this license is designated and serves infants and preschool ages, the professional development hours must be maintained.</p> <p>Licensing staff can recommend facility for licensing.</p>
